Note: KV6114 and KV6124 have exactly the same port markings and size on the back panel.

2 Terminal and Wiring

NC1 : Door Lock 1 Relay Output (NC1)	485-: RS-485 Interface
NO1 : Door Lock 1 Relay Output (NO1)	485+: RS-485 Interface
NC2 : Door Lock 2 Relay Output (NC2)	12 VDC IN: Power Supply Input
NO2 : Door Lock 2 Relay Output (NO2)	GND: Grounding
COM1&COM2: Common Interface	AIN1-AIN4: Analog Input (For Alarm in)

Note: Please refer to the picture aside for details.

3 Installation Accessory

- ① Mounting Plate ② Rain Shield (Optional) ③ Mounting Bracket (Optional)

Note: The dimension of the mounting plate is 124.5 mm × 68 mm × 7.3 mm.
The dimension of the rain shield is 194.49 mm × 84.62 mm × 47 mm.
The dimension of the mounting bracket is 119.58 mm × 46.68 mm × 28.39 mm.

4 Installation

Note: The intallation methods for KV6114 and KV6124 are the same. Here takes KV6114 as an example.

Before You Start

- Make sure all related equipments are power-off during the installation.
- Tools that you need to prepare for installation: Drill and gradienter.

★ Mounting with Gang Box

- Align the mounting holes of the plate with the holes of the gang box, then secure the mounting plate to the wall using 2PCS SC-KA4X25 screws.
- Connect all cables and secure the rear interface cover, then mount the device onto the plate from top to bottom.
- Fix the device on the mounting plate with 1PCS SC-M3X18-T10-SUS-NL screw.

Note: Apply silicone sealant among the cable wiring area to keep the raindrop from entering. Please refer to figure A.

★ Surface Mounting without Rain Shield

- Fix the mounting plate to the wall using 4PCS SC-KA4X25 screws.
- Connect all cables and secure the rear interface cover, then mount the device onto the plate from top to bottom.
- Fix the device on the mounting plate with 1PCS SC-M3X18-T10-SUS-NL screw.

Note: Apply silicone sealant among the cable wiring area to keep the raindrop from entering. Please refer to figure B.

★ Surface Mounting with Rain Shield (Optional)

- Fix the mounting plate and rain shield to the wall using 4PCS SC-KA4X25 screws.
- Connect all cables and secure the rear interface cover, then mount the device onto the plate from top to bottom.
- Fix the device on the mounting plate with 1PCS SC-M3X18-T10-SUS-NL screw.

Note:

- Apply silicone sealant among the cable wiring area to keep the raindrop from entering. Please refer to figure C.
- The package does not include a rain cover, which needs to be purchased separately.

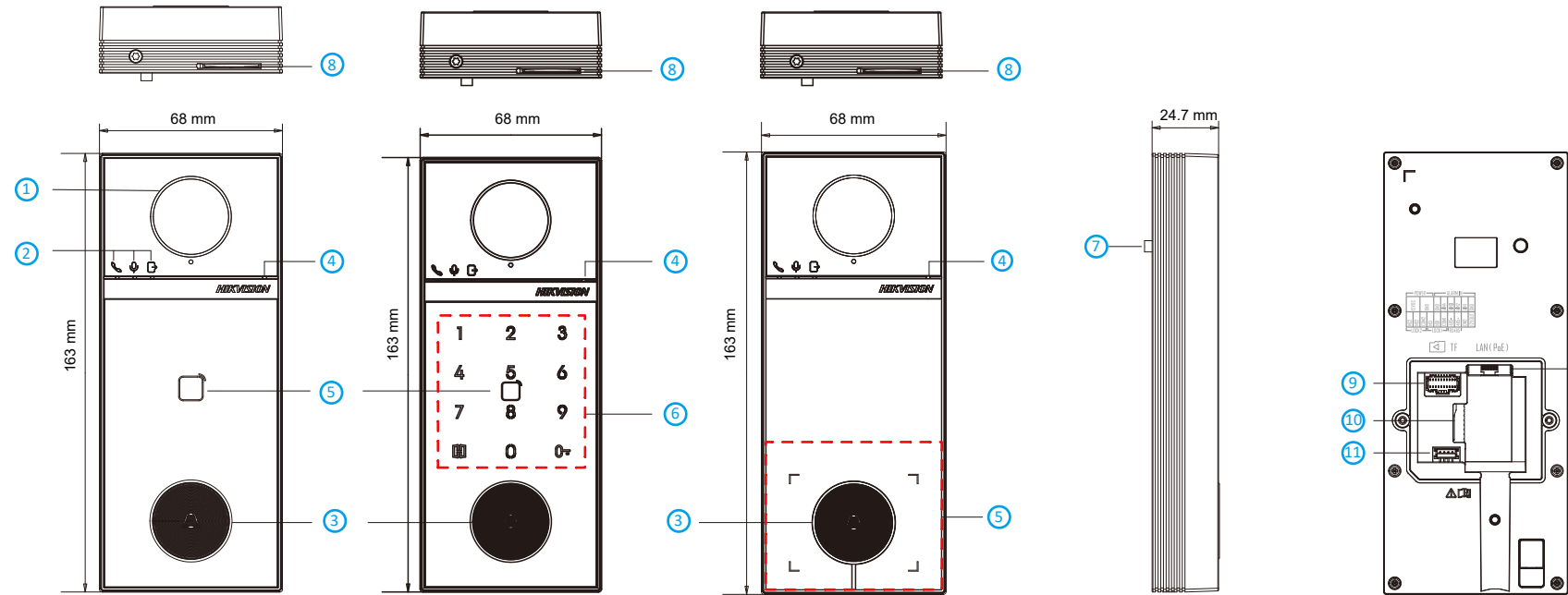
★ Surface Mounting with Rain Shield and Mounting Bracket (Optional)

- Fix the mounting bracket to the wall using 2PCS SC-KA4X25 screws.
- Fix the mounting plate and rain shield to the wall using 4PCS SC-KM4X8-SUS-GB819 screws.
- Connect all cables and secure the rear interface cover, then mount the device onto the plate from top to bottom.
- Fix the device on the mounting plate with 1PCS SC-M3X18-T10-SUS-NL screw.

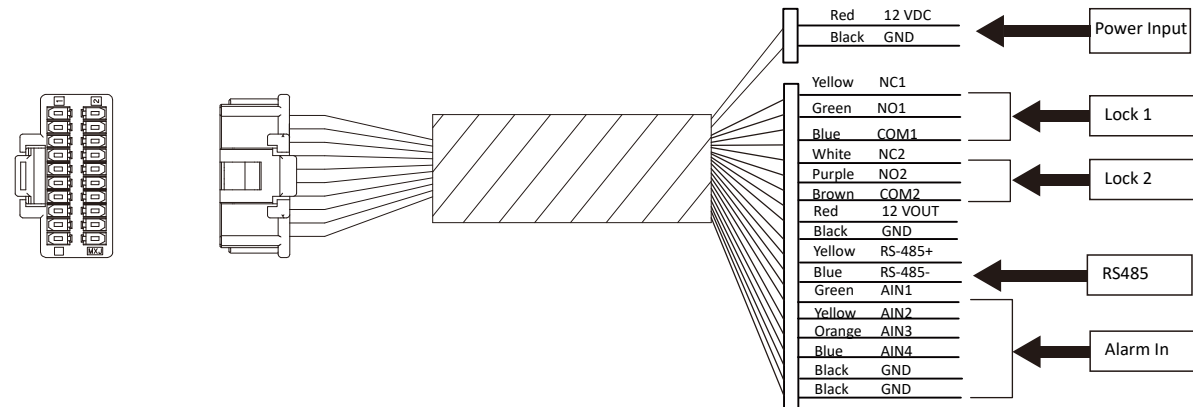
Note:

- Apply silicone sealant among the cable wiring area to keep the raindrop from entering. Please refer to figure D. The package does not include rain cover and mounting bracket. You need to purchase them separately.
- When installing a mounting bracket, the distance between the short side of the bracket and the wall should be greater than 20mm.
- If you want to intall a mouting bracket without a rain shield, the general installation procedure are similar as above. You just need to omit the rain cover installation part. What's more, the screws used in step 2 will be changed to 4PCS SC-KM4X5-SUS-GB819 screws.

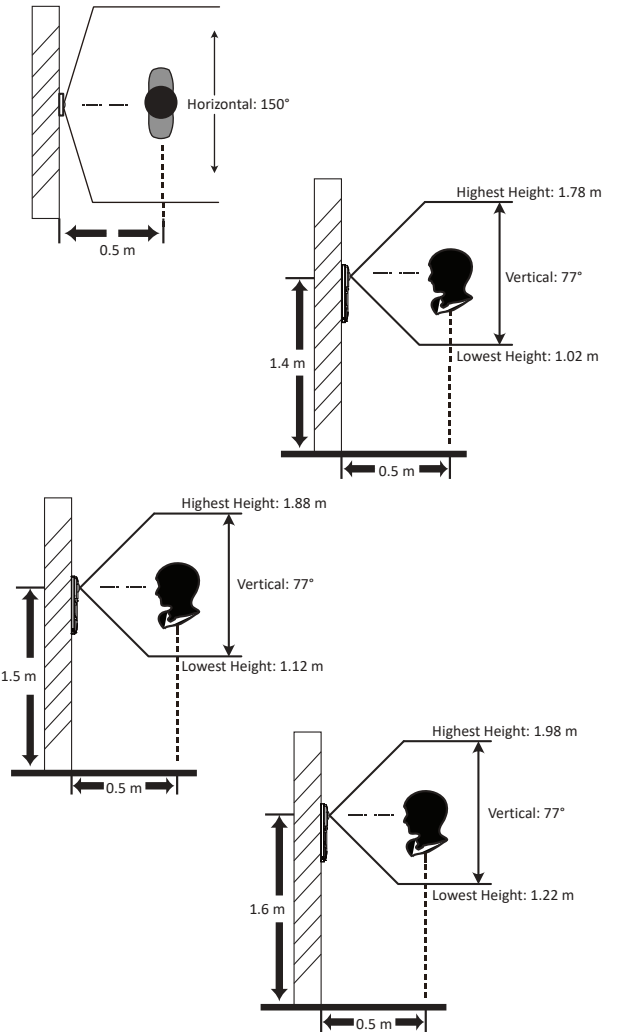
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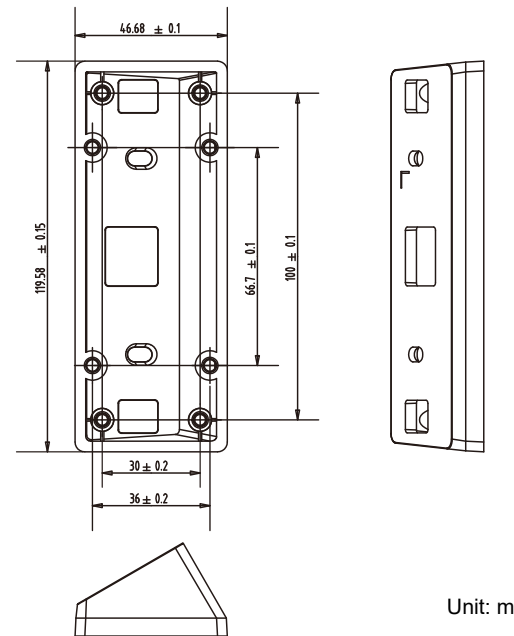
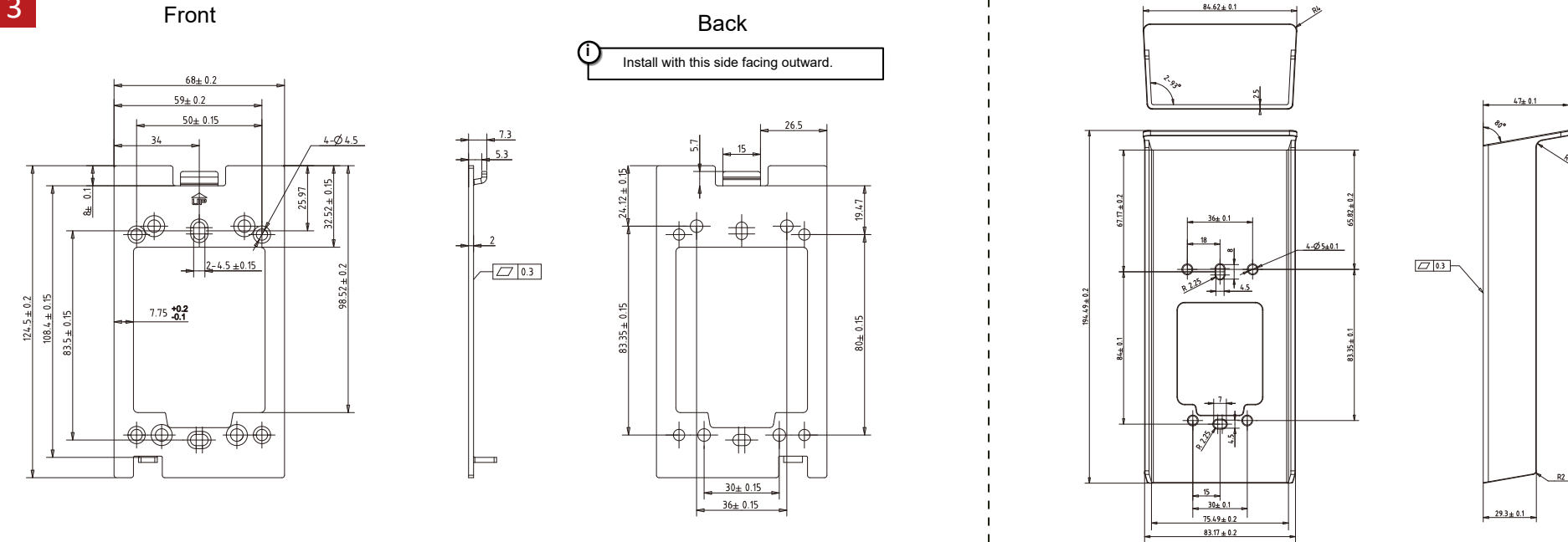

5 Configuration via Web

1 Activate Device via Web

- You are required to activate the device first by settings a strong password before you can use the device.
- Default parameters of door station are as follows:
- Default IP Address: 192.0.0.65.
 - Default Port No.:8000.
 - Default User Name: admin
1. Power on the device, and connect the device to the network.
 2. Enter the IP address into the address bar of the web browser, and click Enter to enter the activation page.
- Note: The computer and the device should belongs to the same subnet.
3. Create and enter a password into the password field.
 4. Confirm the password.
 5. Click OK to activate the device.
- Note: When the device is not activated, the basic operation and remote configuration of device cannot be performed.

2 Access to the Device by Web Browsers

1. In the browser address bar, enter the IP address of the device, and press the Enter key to enter the login page.
2. Enter the user name and password and click Login.

3 Communicate with Indoor Station

1. Click Video Intercom -> Press Button to Call to enter the settings page.
2. Set the parameters.
 - Edit Button Settings for every button.
 - Choose Link Call Schedule for each module.
3. Press button to call indoor station.

4 Issue Card

1. Click Person -> +Add to enter the settings page.
2. Click + Add Card. Present the card on the card reader.
3. When issuing finished, the windows pop up on the settings page.

- Note:
- Only M1 card supported, and M1 card with non-standard shape is recommended.
 - Up to 10000 cards can be issued and managed by these door stations. A voice prompt (No more cards can be issued.) can be heard when the issued card amount exceeds the upper limit.

5 Unlock Door

After issuing cards, you can unlock the door by presenting the issued cards.

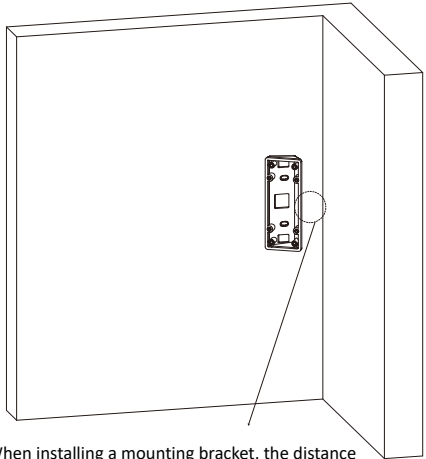

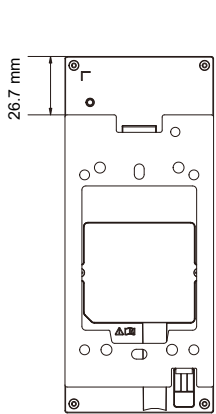
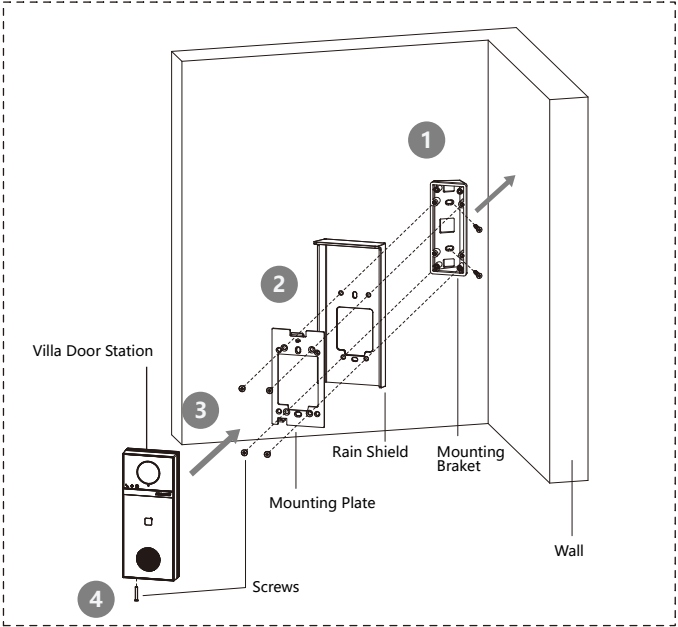

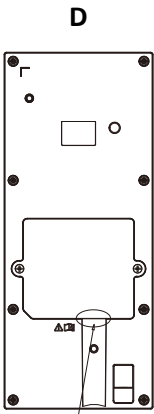
★ Surface Mounting with Rain Shield and Mounting Bracket (Optional)
